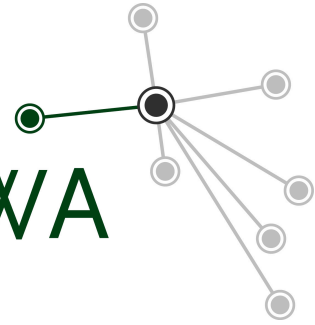

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES & PRESCRIBED FEES

Professional Historian: An annual fee of \$85 is payable by a person who, having been accredited as a Professional Historian under the *National Standard for the Accreditation of Professional Historians in Australia*, wishes to retain that credential. That person has full voting rights. He/she is entitled to use the letters MPHA after his/her name and to cite membership of the Association in connection with his/her work.

Professional Historian (Associate): An annual fee of \$65 is payable by a person who, having been accredited as a Professional Historian (Associate) under the *National Standard for the Accreditation of Professional Historians in Australia*, wishes to retain that credential. That person has full voting rights. He/she is entitled to use the letters APHA after his/her name and to cite membership of the Association in connection with his/her work.

Professional Historian (Retired): An annual fee of \$50 is payable by a person who, having been accredited by PHA (WA) as a Professional Historian for a minimum of five years, wishes to retain that credential but no longer derives or intends to derive income from the practice of history. That person has full voting rights. He/she is entitled to use the letters MPHA but must include the word retired, in brackets, after those letters.

Graduate Historian: An annual fee of \$40 is payable by a person who, having been accredited as a Graduate Historian under the *National Standard for the Accreditation of Professional Historians in Australia*, wishes to retain that credential. That person has full voting rights. He/she may cite membership of the Association in connection with his/her work but may neither claim to be a Professional Historian nor use letters indicative of that status after his/her name.

Historical Researcher: An annual fee of \$40 is payable by a person who, having been accredited as an Historical Researcher under the *National Standard for the Accreditation of Historical Researchers in Australia*, wishes to retain that credential. That person has full voting rights. He/she may cite membership of the Association in connection with his/her work but may neither claim to be a Professional Historian nor use letters indicative of that status after his/her name. The Historical Researcher category of membership is available in some but not all Professional Historians Associations in Australia.

Joining fee: A fee of \$30 is payable by every person who wishes to become a member of the Association. In instances where a member has allowed his/her membership to lapse, a new joining fee will be required if that person applies to rejoin the PHA more than five years after the receipt of his/her last payment of membership dues.
